

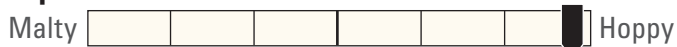
## What's an IPA?

An American adaptation of the classic English India Pale Ale style (originally brewed for export to India), American India Pale Ales are medium-bodied, crisp, clear and pale gold to deep amber in color with a lingering, large white to off-white head. Hops are dominant throughout IPAs aroma, taste and finish, with many examples dry hopped (hops added during fermentation) to increase and enhance aroma. While the flavor balance is decidedly tipped towards hops and bitterness, the malt presence is always large enough to support the hops and keep them from over-powering the palate. Overall, IPAs are smooth, refreshing and hoppy beers, with sufficient supporting malt character, moderate alcohol strength (5.5 – 7.5% abv), and a dry, bitter finish.

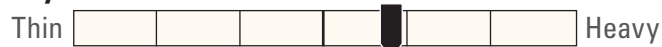
## Brew History

HellRazer IPA, first brewed in 2011 and now available year round, is a medium-bodied, golden IPA that gets in your face from first sweet sip to crisp, dry finish with the exotic tropical fruit flavors and aromas of New Zealand Motueka hops. With just enough malt character to keep the aggressive hop presence and unruly 7.5% abv in check, this brew was seemingly born to kick ass. And RAZE HELL!

## Tasting Notes

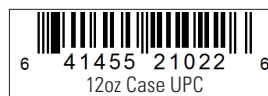
**Aroma:** Intense aroma of tropical fruit and hops.

**Appearance:** Clear, medium golden with white head.

**Flavor:** Hop dominant with a tropical sweetness. Just enough malt for balance.

**Mouthfeel:** Medium bodied with a crisp, dry, tropical finish.

**Overall Impression:** A moderately strong, intensely hoppy IPA.
