What's a Oktoberfest?

An Oktoberfest is a German lager originally credited to Gabriel Sedlmayr, based on the Vienna style developed around 1840. They were traditionally brewed in spring and served in the fall to celebrate the end of the brewing season in Germany, however, the style has become so popular that it is now brewed throughout the year worldwide. Oktoberfest's are typically medium-bodied and dark gold to deep copper in color with a distinct, complex palate with notes of both sweet and toasted malt leading to a clean, dry finish with just enough hops to balance the rich flavor.

Brew History

Mad Bishop has been haunting the congregation with its distinct copper color and rich toasted malt flavor since it was first brewed in 1996. This true German Oktoberfest combines complex aromas and flavors of sweet and toasted malt, a smooth mouthfeel created by an 8 week conditioning (lagering) process, and a clean, crisp finish for a sermon that's easy to swallow.

Aroma: Sweet malty notes and no hop aroma.

Overall Impression: A German-style lager with a clean and crisp flavor profile.
