## What is the eXile Series?

Straight from the DuClaw Brewing Company R&D labs, the eXile Series is a collection of small-batch, experimental brews released seemingly at random with no fanfare. These brews are a way to flex our brewing muscles, explore the unknown, and possibly discover uniquely delicious new brews to add to our beer line-up.

## Brew History

First brewed in 2010, the 2<sup>nd</sup> release in the eXile series, X-2: Imperial Wit, is very similar to our "Sawtooth Belgian Wit", but more intensely flavored, and with a higher alcohol content (9% abv). X-2 is cloudy and gold in color with a thick, white, long lasting head, and medium body with a soft, fluffy texture derived from a small portion of torrifified (puffed) wheat in the grain bill. Dominating flavors and aromas of citrus, coriander and real Curacao bitter orange are well balanced by a subdued hop presence, leading to a spicy, refreshing finish.

## Tasting Notes

**Aroma:** Very spicy with hints of coriander and orange.

**Appearance:** Cloudy(unfiltered) golden with a thin, persistent white head.

**Flavor:** Distinctive coriander/orange flavor followed by other spicy notes and a distinctive yeasty flavor.

**Mouthfeel:** Medium bodied with a rather light mouthfeel and a slight creaminess.

**Overall Impression:** A very flavorful Belgian-style Wit which is spice and fruit flavor dominated. Very refreshing despite its high abv.
